

St Oswald's Hospital – Conditions of Entry

To be eligible for almshouse accommodation at St Oswald's Hospital, The Tythings, Worcester, WR1 1HR, the following conditions of entry apply:

You **must** be over 50 years of age.

You **must** be able to live independently and look after yourself.

Your **must** have been living in the City of Worcester or the parishes listed below for at least two years immediately preceding your application.

You **must** be able to provide a prove that you have need of the charitable assistance of the almshouse accommodation provided by the Trustees of St Oswald's Hospital.

In addition, you are **expected** to take an active part in the life of the community at St Oswald's Hospital, including attendance in the chapel twice a week.
