## Services and Music November 2021

November provides us with a rich calendar of saints and martyrs – a fitting follow-up to our celebration of All Saints’ on November 1st. The Peruvian Dominican, Martin de Porres, whom the Church remembers on November 3<sup>rd</sup> is celebrated for his work with the poor and sick. The story is told that when an epidemic struck Lima he brought many sick people to the community to care for them. Worried by the possibility of contagion, the superior forbade him to bring any more sick people to the house, but Martin continued. His superior questioned his disobedience to which Martin replied, ‘Forgive my error, and please instruct me, for I did not know that the precept of obedience took precedence over that of charity.’ It would be foolish to set aside obedience or to diminish its importance, but St Martin’s example is a reminder to us as we contemplate saintliness during this month of November, that holiness is less about the keeping of rules and more about living and demonstrating a life of love. The saints, with all their shortcomings and nerve, direct us ever more in the path of this love.
