If you have 'been around the block' a few times on this Christian journey, I hope that Easter greeting comes as an old familiar friend: a proclamation that enacts the joy it proclaims. We say it over and over again, in tones that shift between the quiet and effervescent. It is sometimes the strong claim of the gospel, and sometimes an overflow of laughter and surprise

What I love most, though, is that it is a dialogue.

The disciples went from the silent terror of the cross, to a jumble of conversion: 'have you heard?', 'What Mary said was...', 'when he broke bread...', 'and then I saw him', 'so many fish...', 'and he was there with us', 'alive...', 'different...', 'the same...' 'Risen'.

The story is too big for us to make sense of alone — or for it to be one story. We need all the different voices, all the different perspectives, and time to make sense of it all.
